## **OBJECTIVE**

To map, trace, and assess the diffusion of Kremlin FIMI narratives into Croatian discourse using computational discourse analysis.



## QUESTIONS

- 1. \* How are narratives structured?
- 2. Through which channels do they travel?
- 3. What effects do they generate in Croatia?
- 4. Which FIMI toolbox elements can be used in Croatia?



## **METHODOLOGY**

## **Corpus:**

**1. Core speeches** (5): Munich 2007; Crimea 2014; Donetsk/Luhansk recognition 2022; Full scale invasion 2022; Carlson interview 2024.

2. Extended corpus: Total 20 speeches (2007–2025).



## METHODOLOGY

### **Methods:**

**Data preparation:** Lemmatization (NOUN/PNOUN only), phrase merging; stop-words and empty texts removed.


**Quantitative analysis:** Collocations (Hinge words), Guided LDA (Themes), BERT sentiment (Tone).

**Qualitative validation:** KWIC (full-sentence checks); case study review.

**Tools:** Python, Google Colab.



## COLLOCATIONS – HINGE WORDS



Seed words (anchors) example: Ukraine, unity, people (for Russia–Ukraine), West, sovereignty, values (for Russia–West), and NATO, force, enlargement (for Russia–NATO).



## GUIDED LDA

#### Theme 1 (Russia – Ukraine; Legitimisation)

Keywords: ukraine, russia, people, historical unity, bandera, maidan

Narrative: Ukraine is not just a neighbor – it is part of our history, culture, and

spiritual space (Kievan Rus'), it needs our protection.

Most prominent in: 24 February 2022

Theme 2 (Russia – West; Normative contestation)

**Keywords**: west, hegemony, double standards, values sovereignty, rules-based order

**Narrative**: Criticism of Western policies, violations of international law, sovereignty of Russia.

Most prominent in: Carlson interview 2024



## GUIDED LDA

#### Theme 3 (Russia – NATO; Securitisation)

**Keywords:** NATO, force, expansion, enlargement, bloc, bases

Narrative: NATO expansion, threat to Russia, and justification of the "special

military operation."

Most prominent in: Munich 2007



## **KWIC** - FROM STATS TO SENTENCES

#### Theme 1 (Russia – Ukraine)

We will recognise the results of the **referendum**, conducted in accordance with **law** and the will of the people.

(referendum / law)

#### Theme 2 (Russia – West)

The so-called rules-based **order** violates international **law**, applying double standards to suit political needs.

(order / law)

#### Theme 3 (Russia – NATO)

NATO's expansion towards our borders is a direct **threat**, transforming the **bloc** into an offensive instrument.

(threat / bloc)



## BERT SENTIMENT

2007 → Balanced critique – still diplomatic
2014 → Legality/rightness framing – positivity rises
21 Feb 2022 → Accusatory (negative) tone – escalation
24 Feb 2022 → positive and very positive – war framed as moral and emotional duty



## CASE STUDY

#### **EU and NATO Support Activities for Ukraine (EUMAM, NSATU)**

**Context:** Government proposal → political crisis & polarization

Narratives: Involvement in conflict • Proxy war • Lawful target • Threat to sovereignty

Relevance: Parallels in Putin's speeches

Analytical tools: Core speech analyses + Fuzzy Matching (phrases), and Word2Vec


(links: sovereignty/West/army/mission)

Resilience/FIMI toolbox: \* Understand: Publish lexicons| Prevent: Prebunk

peaks | 🙅 Contain/Mitigate: Target spikes | 📢 Recover Post-spike explainers

| 🦠 **Evaluate:** Measure.

**RESULT**: FIMI narratives act as **force multipliers of division** — exporting Moscow's rhetoric to fuel institutional rifts in Croatia.
